Being named a BWC is an elite designation that signifies each designee's dedication to providing outstanding commuter benefits, such as free or low-cost bus passes and vanpool fares, carpool programs, and comprehensive telework programs. Those that apply for and meet the BWC National Standard of Excellence are appointed to a select list of BWCs and receive access to programming, services, and one-on-one support tailored to each respective award category.



The following are additional statistics to provide a more detailed view of BWC Members and the commuters who have access to the transportation benefits they provide.



BWC EMPLOYERS:

BEST

- Nearly one-third of all employers who are BWC members reported they offer benefits to employees at multiple workplace locations.
- 470,552 BWC workers were offered commuter benefits by their employers in 2023.

BWC COLLEGES / UNIVERSITIES:

- Around 40% of all college and university BWC members reported that they provide benefits for multiple campus locations.
- 1,176,552 total BWC commuters are offered commuter benefits at colleges/universities nearly 60% are students.


BWC SITES:
