- 75 subway stations


Our Commitment to Sustainability

Our Commuter Benefits

The BWC designation applies to 16 of the City's largest workplaces, covering more than 16,000 employees. We offer:

- A hybrid work model which allows employees to work remotely 2-3 days per week (ModernTO)
- Use of City fleet vehicles to meet operational needs
- City offers supports for staff to walk, cycle, carpool, and take transit to and from work
- Membership in the Smart Commute Program



The Smart Commute Program

Smart Commute is a regional program supported and implemented by municipalities in the Greater Toronto and Hamilton Area and the City of Greater Sudbury with the goal to reduce SOV trips, reduce congestion and GHG emissions.

Through Smart Commute, City employees have access to:

- Annual campaigns such as Bike Month to promote active transportation
- An online carpool ride-matching tool
- Emergency ride home program

Commuter Benefits Highlight: Campus Shuttles

Complimentary shuttle services to transport community members on specific routes such as the Glendon-Keele Shuttle, a Village Shuttle and VanGO a mobility service.

The Glendon-Keele shuttle gives staff and students the opportunity to relax or get work done while travelling between campuses.



- > 45-minute trip one-way
- > 12 departures per day from each campus
- Riders can reserve up to 10 rides per 5-day period using the York University Mobile Order Reservation App
- Additional shuttle service brings students from Keele Campus to "The Village" student housing area
- > Outbound-only service 7 days per week in the evening

York University has a long history of sustainability. We were the home of the first environmental studies faculty in North America, as well as Ontario's first transportation management association.
